To prevent these problems, Profilitec has developed **BALCOTEC**, a system designed to protect outdoor flooring by uncoupling the ceramic covering from terrace and balcony substrates incorporating anti-fracture, loadresistance and waterproofing functions.

Description

FLOORTEC is the key component of the **BALCOTEC** system, ensuring **secondary waterproofing**, **uncoupling**, **vapour pressure relief** and **load resistance**. Also ideal for indoor tile installations.

Material

The **FLOORTEC** membrane is made of high-density polyethylene, with spunbond TNT (non-woven fabric) thermally laminated on the underside. The geometric configuration of the membrane is made up of cylindrical cavities that are 3 mm in height, arranged with a constant horizontal and vertical pitch, which during installation are filled with thin-set adhesive, thus forming a solid column structure.





Technology

The (HDPE) high density polyethylene membrane has a **cylindrical cavity structure**. This also includes undercut portions for a **mechanical grip** of the thin-set adhesive once it is applied.

The geometric design of the membrane incorporates the ideal ratio of full to empty cavities which **minimizes** the **amount** of **thin-set adhesive needed** compared to other uncoupling systems.

The surface has been "roughened" to provide a strong bond to the thin-set adhesive as well as to allow the use of chalk-lines that will not "dust" off during tile instalation. The woven fabric on the underside of the **FLOORTEC** is thermally laminated during production to prevent problems associated to the breakdown of adhesives that can dissolve when in contact with thin-set, which can be an issue with other uncoupling membranes.

The overall thickness of the membrane is 3.25 mm.

Warnings

The adhesives and coating materials that are used in conjunction with the **BALCOTEC** system must be suitable for the intended use, i.e. suitable for the specific application and the type of surface on which they will be used.

It is particularly important that the coating materials are able to withstand environmental challenges. They must be able to withstand prolonged contact with water, thus protecting the structural integrity of the installation, and be resistant to frost, in order to avoid damage caused by temperature variations. When installing floors, it is essential to consider the presence of humidity contained within the substrate, particularly if the screed is not completely cured. In these cases, it is advisable to **carefully follow the instructions** regarding **secondary waterproofing** (see dedicated paragraph on **page 31**) during the application of the **FLOORTEC** membrane. This ensures adequate protection against humidity emanating from the substrate, helping to preserve the integrity of the floor over time.

When laying **FLOORTEC** in outdoor environments, it is recommended to protect the work area from direct sunlight both during installation and in the first hours after installing the membrane. This helps to prevent the formation of adverse environmental conditions that could compromise correct drying and negatively influence the final result of the installation.

In the case of traffic areas, **protect the area** with panels or walkway protection boards.

Types of support for FLOORTEC

Before beginning the installation, make sure that the supports are:

- **flat**, so as to avoid any unevenness that could compromise the appearance and durability of the floor. Take care to correct any irregularities, using appropriate leveling products. This will ensure a uniform surface for laying **FLOORTEC** membrane, and flooring;
- **cleaned** from any residues of dust, dirt or substances that could prevent optimal adhesion of the adhesive;
- load-bearing.

CEMENT SCREEDS

Current regulations establish that cement screeds must undergo a **curing period** of at least **28 days** (~ one week per cm of thickness) and have a residual humidity of less than 2%, according to the volume carbide method, **before being considered ready for tile installation**. However, even after this period of time, floating screeds and heated floors may still show deformations and cracks due to mechanical stresses or temperature changes.

The use of **FLOORTEC** offers a significant advantage in this context, as it **allows the membrane to be installed directly on the concrete screed as soon as it becomes walkable**, thus not having to wait for the entire curing time.

The **FLOORTEC** membrane also offers an **uncoupling function**, effectively **compensating for tension** build up and preventing cracks and/or deformations of the screed from being transferred to the ceramic covering, especially in environments subject to high and frequent temperature changes.

The application of **FLOORTEC** therefore speeds up the flooring installation process and represents an effective solution to mitigate the problems associated with deformations and cracks of the subfloors over time, ensuring a succesful installation.

PLATES AND BALCONIES

In the case of concrete slabs or balconies below grade, the **FLOORTEC** membrane, installed under the ceramic covering, can perform the additional function of a **secondary waterproofing** system.

WARNINGS FOR SECONDARY WATERPROOFING

It is important to carefully follow the specific warnings regarding waterproofing to ensure effective **protection against water infiltration and humidity** that could damage both the floor and the underlying structure over time.

Before proceeding with the installation of the **FLOORTEC** membrane, it is crucial to ensure that the support (concrete, screed) has an adequate slope to **facilitate the proper flow of water**. In the case of restoration work, if the existing floor is still sufficiently anchored and has a suitable slope, it can be retained and used as a support.

However, it is important to accurately assess the existing floor's condition and, if necessary, remove the parts that are not sufficiently adherent before installing the **FLOORTEC** membrane. Any gaps or irregularities in the slope must be restored using mortars specifically formulated for this purpose, thus ensuring a solid and uniform base for the installation of the membrane and the ceramic floor.

The mixture is made by combining one liter of water with 3 kg of KOLLTEC.

The equipment must be cleaned with water if the product is wet, and mechanically if the product has already hardened.

Warnings

Store **FIXXTEC** cartridges in cool, frost-free places, away from heat sources and direct exposure to UV rays. Opened cartridges have a limited shelf life.

The optimum operating temperature for substrate and sealant is between 15°C and 25°C.

Be careful when using alcohol or alkyd resins contained in paints as they can interfere with the hardening process of the sealant and reduce the drying time.

The hardness and thickness of the paint film can compromise the elasticity of the sealant and lead to the cracking of the painted layer.

Application method

The substrate must be sufficiently clean, solid, load-bearing and free of elements or substances that may compromise its grip.

Apply **FIXXTEC** to the substrate.

Distribute the adhesive over the entire surface, applied with a spatula.

Apply the material to be bonded as quickly as possible over the entire surface and without leaving empty spaces.

If **FIXXTEC** is used as a **joint sealant**, it must be smoothed immediately after application and any excess material immediately removed.

The system has a square-section drain pipe and a rectangular flange covered with **TNT** to adapt it to the parapet and to provide an adequate bonding surface for the **FOILTEC** waterproofing membrane.

Material

The horizontal outlet is made of **TPE** thermoplastic material and also has a TNT surface and a **FOILTEC** gusset suitable for perfectly connecting it to the secondary waterproofing system of the terrace. The package contains 2 drains and 2 gussets.

Application and function

The **SHOWERTEC STC-DP** horizontal drain system consists of a drain with a sloping horizontal rectangular-section outlet and a waterproofing gusset.



Application areas

Thanks to the size of the cross-section of their drainage channel, **SHOWERTEC BALCONIES STC-DP** drains can be used in private homes, but also in hotels or public facilities.


Application method

The subfloor must have sufficient load-bearing capacity and be sloped.

1. The **SHOWERTEC BALCONIES STC-DP** drain has a sloping rectangular-section drain pipe (48 x 57 mm) that must be inserted and bonded or mechanically fixed into an opening in the parapet.

2. Apply **FLOORTEC** to the screed, positioning it flush with the drain flange and adhesive by overlapping the appropriate pre-cut **FOILTEC** plug using **KOLLTEC**.

Description

SHOWERTEC BALCONIES STC-DC is a drain for balconies and terraces with a vertical outlet, equipped with a height-adjustable support and a sturdy stainless steel grate.

Application and function

The outdoor drain system in the **SHOWERTEC** balconies range include both a horizontal drain with slope and a vertical drain.

The latter consists of a drain with a vertical outlet, a waterproofing plug and an adjustable metal grate. The grate has a support that allows a perfect connection with the ceramic covering of varying heights. The flange of the drain system has both holes and a Velcro surface for a secure grip with **KOLLTEC** and with the pre-cut **FOILTEC** gusset, to achieve a waterproofed assembly. It can be used in private homes, hotels and public facilities, due to the presence of fixing screws for the grate and the 150mm long installation pipe.

Material

The grate support and the drain outlet are made of top quality ABS, which allows a perfect fit and millimetric adjustment of the grate positioning relative to the finished surface of the flooring. In this regard, the grate support is supplied with the practical **rigid assembly cap** so that the grate can be conveniently mounted at the end of the installation, preventing debris from entering while flooring.

The outlet is printed with a Velcro suitable for bonding with **KOLLTEC**. To complete the installation, the **FOILTEC** waterproofing membrane gusset is supplied, cut to measure for this application. The grate is a solid and resistant block of **AISI304 stainless steel** designed without sharp edges, an exclusive Profilitec design.

Grate finishes: polished steel (IL) and brushed steel (IS) Installation pipe length: 150mm

Fields of application

SHOWERTEC BALCONIES drains can be used in private homes, but also in hotels or public facilities, thanks to the presence of screws to prevent accidental removal of the grate.

Application method

The subfloor must have sufficient load-bearing capacity and be sloped.

1. The **SHOWERTEC BALCONIES STC-DC** vertical drain must be connected to the drain pipe of the structure.

2. After measuring the connection, if necessary, shorten the pipe by calculating the size of the hydraulic connection joint and the installation height of the floor by cutting it with a saw, ensure a straight line, with the help of a support so as not to break the drain flange (image **1.1**).

3. Make sure that the perforated flange of the drain outlet is in contact with the screed.

4. To waterproof the joint between the drain outlet and the surface of the screed previously waterproofed with the **BALCOTEC** system, the **FOILTEC** gusset supplied with the drain is required. The gusset must be set with **KOLLTEC** in a full bed, centered and overlapping the adjacent **FLOORTEC** membrane set flush with the flange.


5. The system can be combined with different types of floor coverings, such as ceramic tile, natural stone, or similar.


The grate support, with the construction cap still mounted, must be spread with ceramic adhesive all around the toothed edge and on the adjustment ring. The support has a diameter that allows a certain freedom of positioning of the ring inside the flange allowing the possibility of aligning the grate horizontally with the joints of the tile surface.

After having laid the ceramic covering around the grate support, slowly press on the construction cap until final leveling with the finished flooring.

6. Once the installation is complete and the joints are grouted, replace the construction cap with the **SHOWERTEC STC-DC** steel grate using a PH2 (cross) screwdriver and reusing the same ones for the final fixing of the grate.


Warnings and maintenance

Application method

The substrate must be sufficiently regular and the edge of the screed straight.

Choose the profile most suitable for the height of the tile and for the type of installation and thickness of the screed.

Position it aproximately one centimeter from the front, along the edge of the surface to be tiled and install it before laying the tile and the **FLOORTEC** uncoupling membrane, complete the **secondary waterproofing**, using **KOLLTEC** to seal using the **FOILTEC** strip.

Leave a suitable space (aprox. 5 mm) between the different elements for thermal expansion, masking the joint with the joining element between the profiles themselves and between profiles and their corner accessories.

When laying the ceramic covering, leave about 5 mm to allow for **final sealing with FIXXTEC** around the perimeter.

Description

Technical profiles that absorb thermal expansion and contraction of the flooring material, protecting against cracks and assuring a quality result. The products of the **COFLEX** family are used as fractionation joints to divide tiled areas into smaller zones.

Material

The **COFLEX** profiles made of aluminum and those made of AISI304 stainless steel incorporate compresible material made of EPDM.

The **COFLEX** profiles in synthetic material have a PVC structure co-extruded with a synthetic material of high technical characteristics in terms of elasticity, durability and resistance to the main diluted chemical agents. Available in different colors, they can find a chromatic match with the joints and with the material used for the covering. They can be used both indoors and outdoors.

Both aluminum **COFLEX** and AISI304 stainless steel **COFLEX** profiles include an expansion strip made of EPDM.



Fields of application

The range of expansion joints is wide, and understanding which profile to choose is not a complex decision. It all depends on the type of flooring (material and size, width of the joints, characteristics of the adhesives and stuccos) and the use for which it is intended. You can choose between the families of driveway joints and pedestrian joints, which differ between internal and external use.

Application method

The substrate must be sufficiently regular and the edge of the screed must be straight.

Choose a joint with a height exactly equal to the thickness of the tile.

The joint must not under any circumstances protrude from the surface of the covering but can be lower by 0,5 mm to 1 mm.

Position the joint in correspondence with the existing joint at the level of the screed (if not present, cut the screed for at least 2/3 of its thickness).

Proceed with the installation of the tiles along the flanges of the joint, placing them aligned with the profile, making sure that the latter are solidly anchored and sunk into the adhesive.

Leave a joint between the tile and the profile as wide as that between the floor tiles and then grout.

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

BALCOTEC SYSTEM

1. The substrate must be cleaned of any dust, dirt or substances that could interfere with the adhesion of the adhesive and compromise the quality of the installation.

The surface must be uniform and free of significant unevenness that could affect the final appearance of the floor or compromise its stability. If necessary, it is advisable **to level the surface of the substrate** using mortars or materials suitable for this purpose, making sure to obtain a flat surface before installing **FLOORTEC**.

2. The thin-set adhesive to install the **FLOORTEC** membrane to the substrate depends on the substrate. It is crucial to select an adhesive that not only adheres firmly to the substrate, but also mechanically anchors to the **FLOORTEC** membrane fabric.

For most substrates, a good choice is to use a **thin-bed**, **hydraulic-setting thin-set adhesive**. This type of adhesive offers excellent adhesion and rapid setting, facilitating the installation process. It is advisable to prepare the adhesive so that it has a fluid consistency in order to allow uniform distribution and good penetration between the **FLOORTEC** membrane and the substrate.

During the adhesive preparation phase, it is essential to carefully follow the instructions provided by the manufacturer to obtain the desired consistency. It is also important to always check the compatibility between the adhesive ingredients and the materials of the substrate and the **FLOORTEC** membrane to avoid adhesion problems or deterioration over time.

3. To apply the adhesive to the substrate effectively, it is advisable to use a suitable notched trowel. We recommend a 6x6 mm toothed trowel.

Before applying the adhesive, make sure the trowel is clean and free of adhesive residue or other materials that could compromise adhesion. Make sure to apply enough adhesive to completely cover the surface and ensure good adhesion between the substrate and the **FLOORTEC** membrane, considering an average consumption of approximately 1.5 kg/m².

4. Measure and cut the **FLOORTEC** rolls to the desired length, using a utility knife or construction scissors. Make sure the cuts are clean and straight to ensure correct installation.

Once the adhesive has been applied to the substrate and is still fresh, place the **FLOORTEC** on the adhesive bed. Carefully place the membrane rolls side by side, making sure not to leave gaps or overlaps.

Immediately press the membrane using a plastic float or a weighted roller. Make sure to follow a single direction when pressing to ensure uniform and complete adhesion between the membrane and the substrate.

During application, pay attention to the open time of the adhesive, making sure to complete the installation within the time specified by the manufacturer to avoid the adhesive drying out and compromising adhesion.

It is advisable to apply the **FLOORTEC membrane well taut** already during installation, applying light traction to avoid creases or air bubbles. The particular shape and the material itself of the membrane significantly reduce the "memory" effect, i.e. the tendency of the material to curl back.

The presence of a second person can greatly facilitate the application, especially during installation and pressing of the membrane to ensure a uniform and defect-free surface.

To place a sheet next to the one previously laid without having to maintain a minimum distance between the individual sheets, make sure that the first sheet has been correctly positioned and fixed to the support using the appropriate adhesive.

Gently press the second sheet near the first, keeping them aligned and making sure that the surfaces adapt perfectly to the support without forming creases or air bubbles.

The translucency of the material allows continuous monitoring of adhesive coverage under the **FLOORTEC**.

In case **FLOORTEC** is used not only as an uncoupling membrane but also as a secondary **waterproofing** system for the screed, **it is important to carefully seal the joints, flaps, connections** and open sides using **Profilitec** components.

Carefully follow the waterproofing instructions in the product data sheet.

5. To protect the newly installed FLOORTEC membrane and prevent it from detaching from the substrate, limit traffic, or place protective sheets in areas of transit on the construction site.

If the **FLOORTEC** membrane is installed outdoors, additional measures may be necessary to protect it from adverse environmental conditions. This may include the use of materials to protect the membrane from damage caused by the exposure to the sun. During the installation of the **FLOORTEC** membrane and in the first hours after, it is important to avoid direct exposure to sunlight. Prolonged exposure to UV rays could cause damage to the membrane or compromise its performance.

During the installation of the membrane, it is crucial to protect the surface from exposure to rain as water can compromise adhesion.

Before applying the adhesive for laying ceramic tiles on the **FLOORTEC** membrane, make sure to remove any stagnant water from the cavities of the membrane.

6. After applying the **FLOORTEC** membrane, the ceramic can be laid immediately using an adhesive suitable for the type of flooring. **There is no need to wait**. The choice of notched trowel for the application of the adhesive depends on the size of the tile to ensure uniform distribution of the adhesive.



When setting tile, it is essential to respect the open time of the adhesive to ensure effective bonding. Especially in cases where the coverings are subject to particular mechanical stresses or in external applications, it is advisable to carry out a full bed installation, following the current technical regulations such as UNI 11493-1. This method ensures uniform distribution of the adhesive and better overall stability of the floor.

After applying the **FLOORTEC** membrane, it is advisable to **smooth the cylindrical cavities** of the membrane with the flat side of the trowel. The quantity of adhesive for a normal installation is approximately 1.4 - 1.8 kg/m2. Immediately after, it is possible to proceed with the installation of the ceramic in a single procedure, using a bed of thin-set adhesive with proper notches. However, in particular construction site situations, it is permitted to first smooth the cavities and then proceed with the laying of the adhesive for the bedding of the covering. It is advisable to carefully remove the dust by vacuuming it or, if necessary, by applying an adhesion promoter to ensure better adhesion between the adhesive and the support. Before proceeding with the installation, it is essential to always check for any incompatibilities between the materials used, to avoid problems of adhesion or deterioration over time.

7. For expansion joints, perimeter joints, and flexible connections with fixed structures, it is essential to carefully follow the **specific instructions provided in this document**, in addition to the normal rules of good practice and current regulations.

Secondary waterproofing

To ensure correct secondary waterproofing and sealing of the **FLOORTEC** membrane joint areas, **apply the FOILTEC/15 waterproofing strips with the KOLLTEC waterproofing glue**.

The same strips must also be used to seal the connections between the floor and the covering, as well as to close the perimeter area of the membrane. Make the turn-up between the wall and the floor using the **FOILTEC/15** strip, taking care to place 5 cm on the floor and 10 cm on the wall. In the case of internal or external corners, apply the appropriate **FOILTEC/I** or **FOILTEC/E** corners with **KOLLTEC**.

The strips also allow for an easily obtained connection with **fixed structures** such as door and window frames and perimeter edges in metal, wood or plastic material. **Apply the FIXXTEC one-component sealant** first to these fixed structures, then fix the remaining part of the **FOILTEC/15** strip with **KOLLTEC** in a full bed over the **FLOORTEC** membrane.

It is important to check that the **FIXXTEC** sealant is suitable for the material of the fixed structure before proceeding with the application.

These systems include special pre-cut **FOILTEC** membrane gussets that allow for safe and quick connection to the **FLOORTEC** system using **KOLLTEC** adhesive.

SHOWERTEC drainage systems are ideal for installation in areas that require floor drainage, both with horizontal and vertical drain, ensuring complete waterproofing and perfect integration with the Profilitec system, ensuring a reliable and long-lasting installation.

Installation instructions

Minimum size of the ceramic covering: 5x5 cm Minimum thickness of the ceramic covering 6 mm





1_ The support must be load-bearing, flat, clean and without roughness. Spread the cement adhesive with a 6x6 mm notched trowel.




2_ Set the border starting from the corners.




3_ Cut the **FLOORTEC** membrane before and then lay it on the previously applied adhesive.




4_ Use a plastic trowel to press the membrane adequately.




5_ In the case of multiple gussets, position the next gusset adjacent to the one already set, without overlapping them.




6_ When used in combination with the **BORDERTEC** perimeter profiles, place **FLOORTEC** next to the blanking of the profile and seal them by applying **KOLLTEC** adhesive over the membrane and the blanking, eventually placing the **FOILTEC** waterproofing strip on top of it all, bonding half of it to the membrane and half to the profile.




7_ Make sure to smooth the **KOLLTEC** adhesive and completely fill the cylindrical cavities of the membrane with a smooth trowel and then with a suitable notched trowel (3x3 or 4x4mm).




8_ Apply FOILTEC/15 to seal the joints and folds; make the membrane adhere to the adhesive using a plastic trowel.






9_ In the perimeter folds the strip will extend 10cm vertically (wall edge) and 5cm horizontally (floor).



10_ Spread the cement adhesive filling the cavities of **FLOORTEC**, pressing it with the smooth trowel; then spread it with the notched trowel and set the ceramic covering and the expansion joint, where required.





11_ The joints between the bordertec profile and the tile can be filled with the multipurpose sealant **FIXXTEC**.


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
